Theme- Superheroes and
People Who Help Us.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development . We will:

- Recall past events-what Christmas presents did everyone receive?
- What does everyone know about Superheroes and which ones are the children familiar with?
- Discuss how actions might affect others and how a Superhero might protect us-which superpower would we like to have.

Physical Development . We will:

- Introduce 'Finger Gym' activities each week to develop fine motor skills; untie the trapped Superheroes from string, peg numbers on capes on a line in order, make a 'Super Veg'.
- Move like a Superhero in the sports hall, e.g, jump, leap and roll.
- Think about how a Superhero keeps fit and healthy.



Literacy . We will:

- Look for different logos in different jobs i.e. fire service/police service.
- Set up files and note pads in the role play area.
- Use a variety of objects to mark-make, e.g, carrots and toothbrushes.

Mathematics . We will:

- Count and sort objects according to size and colour.
- Match numerals and quantity together. (Sort peas to corresponding numbers 1-20)

Expressive Art and Design . We will:

- Use various materials to make individual capes.
- Change the role play area into a Superhero hideout.

Understanding the World . We will:

- Talk about a healthy diet and make a fruit kebab.
- Make a den for a toy Superhero in the tuff spot
